

Instructions:

Getting started:

1. Print the 8 bingo cards and call tiles. If you have card stock paper print the game on that.
2. Cut out each of the call tiles.
3. Scramble the call tiles and keep them in a bag.

Game rules:

Object: To get three in a row: across, down, or diagonal.

Number of players: 3-9

How to play: Have one caller and 2 – 8 players. The caller scrambles the call tiles and reads them out randomly. The players each get one bingo card and one information card. Players can use the facts on the information card to help them find a plant that fits the statement that is read. When a statement is read that is true for a plant on this bingo card place an object (coin or piece of paper) the box containing the plant. For example, if the card says, “Used to treat fever,” then you can place an object over the willow. You can only place one object on the card per statement even if it is true for more than one plant. You must only choose one plant each round and you cannot move an object once it has been placed on your card.

Winning: The first person to get a three in a row wins the game.
