



## Nature Journal Prompt

**Topic:**The sky

**Things to notice:** What is in the sky: clouds, the moon, stars, birds, insects. The color of what you see. For example, are the clouds light or dark? Are things moving? If things are moving, are they fast or slow? Is it windy? Do things seem close or far away? How does the air feel (wet or dry, hot or cold)? How does the air smell? Where is there light? Is it bright or dark?

**Questions to ask:** Why are things moving (or not moving)? How do the things I see relate to what I hear? (For example, do I see rain drops and hear water hitting the ground.) What is the source of the odors I smell? (flowers, skunk, grass)
