2022 North Bay TREX participants will work on prescribed fire skills, taskbooks, attend trainings and seminars as part of a team while burning in diverse landscapes and ecologies (redwoods, mixed conifer forests, oak woodlands, grasslands and coastal prairies, and shrub). In exchange, participants will be helping to train and build up others by providing their experience, expertise, and/or equipment, and helping to create a positive prescribed fire culture in the SF Bay Area.

Weekend sessions to help maintain your work/life balance

This modified TREX event will take place over a series of 3-day weekends (Friday-Sunday) from mid-November to mid-January, with additional burn opportunities mid-week throughout the event.
